Requirements for a Annual Artist:

Any Hull Artist member may request to be placed on the Annual Artist list. If the allotted number of Annual Artists in the Gallery is full at 16 participants, their name will be placed on the waiting list; on a first come, first in bases.

An Annual Artist is entitled to one equitable square footage of wall space or table space to showcase and sell their artwork in the Gallery for a year. Artwork will be placed throughout the Gallery per the Hanging Committee for optimum sales and customer experience. Annual Artists will need to be willing to share in the equal staffing responsibilities to staff the Gallery. For any new artist not familiar with the requirements needed to handle sales or retail selling techniques, one on one training will be available until the artist is comfortable to man the Gallery independently.

Dues of **\$20** per month must be paid on a quarterly bases; or with special pre-monthly arrangement with the Gallery's treasurer, Terry McMahon. Checks are payable to Hull Artists.

A 30% commission will be taken on all sales.

An Annual Artist may, for any reason, withdraw from the Gallery. But, the withdrawal must happen at the beginning of a new quarter and written notice must be given to the Hanging Committee 30 day in advance.

Requirements for a Seasonal Artist:

Any Hull Artists member may request to be placed on the list of Seasonal Artists.

A Seasonal Artist has the opportunity to showcase and sell their artwork in the Gallery on a 3 month bases and will be selected by lottery, based on the number of wall and table spaces available on that given quarter. Seasonal Artists will be given the same equitable square footage as the Annual Artists and their artwork will be placed throughout the Gallery by the Hanging Committee for optimum sales and customer experience.

If selected as a Seasonal Artist, the artist will be notified by the Hanging Committee approximately 3 weeks in advance of the up-coming quarterly transition.

Dues of **\$45** per month must be paid on a quarterly bases; in advance of participation in the Gallery. Check to be payable to Hull Artists. (Drop off check at the Gallery or mail to Hull Artists, P.O. Box 277, Hull, MA 02045).

Seasonal Artists will required to participate for the entire 3 months. A notice will go out when the next quarter is coming up and any HA member may add his or her name to the lottery for participation in the new quarter.

A Seasonal Artist will need to work directly with the Hanging Committee to determine what amount of artwork & craft items their “space” will accommodate. This will take place approximately 2 weeks prior to the quarterly transition date.

A 30% commission will be taken on all sales.

Note: for any artists who earns over \$600 in 2020 will be sent a 1099 tax form.

Potential Option for both Annual & Seasonal Artists:

An artist who wishes to have the opportunity to showcase and sell their artwork as a wall AND craft/ table artist may do so. This would however mean that fewer pieces of your wall art would be hung and your craft space would be less than craft artist with one medium.

The Gallery will accommodate 25 members in each quarter.

Up to 16 Annual Artists

Up to 9 Seasonal Artists

2020 Quarterly Dates

All quarterly transitions will take place on Sundays - at the close of the Gallery. The Hanging Committee will notify all artists on pick up and drop off dates.
