



CALL FOR ART and CRAFT INSTRUCTORS

Hull Artists is excited to expand our programming to better serve the needs of our community. We received a grant from the Hull Cultural Council to provide “Creative Art and Craft Classes” at the Hull Council on Aging (COA) Senior Center. The classes will offer a series of introductory art sessions covering a variety of media techniques. Most classes will be “hands-on” in which participants will leave with a finished piece of artwork. The topics are up to the teachers.

- **Topics**
 - Creative “self-contained” workshops that produce a finished product the student can take (or finish at) home. Recent examples: collages, greeting cards, cutting boards, and mosaics.
 - Instruction in a medium or craft providing introductory or other skill levels (e.g., photography skills)
- **Frequency and Length of Sessions and Classes**
 - 1-period session of 90-120 minutes
 - 2-4 session classes offered weekly
 - Classes may be repeated (i.e., offered multiple times)
 - Class schedules are published on a bi-monthly basis
- **Availability of Time Slots (Monday-Thursday with various time options)**
- **Starting Dates:**
 - The Jan/Feb calendar has been published and a new schedule will soon be published for Mar/April, so get your requests in ASAP. For late applications, classes may still be offered, but won’t be promoted in the next newsletter.
- **Commitment by the Instructor**
 - 1 to 4 class sessions
- **Cost to Students:** None
- **Stipends to Instructors from Hull Artists**
 - \$50 for each class session (up to 2 hours), a maximum of \$100 per class.
 - Additional payment from the COA may be available.
- **Materials**
 - Provided by the instructor who may keep them
 - Reimbursement of up to \$50 per class will be paid by Hull Artists
- **Promotion**
 - By the COA in their bimonthly newsletter, social media, and elsewhere
 - By HA through emails, the website, social media, etc.
 - By the instructor
- **Follow-Up Lessons/Activities**
 - Instructors may offer “private” classes to students, but not at the Center
